



Share the Warmth will temporarily close for renovations

From September 30 to November 4 inclusive, Share the Warmth will suspend its services due to major renovations. Throughout October, the food bank and community lunches will be closed to allow for this work. When the doors reopen in November, some major changes will be implemented. The good news? The food bank and community lunches will become free. In addition, new hours will be offered for the food bank: Tuesdays from 10 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m., and Thursdays from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. Another new feature: a market area will be integrated into the food bank, where it will be possible to purchase fruits, vegetables, eggs and other basic products at affordable prices. There will be no limit on the number of visits to this space, reserved for members.
