OUR FOOD SECURITY PROGRAMS

Our food programs aim to ensure better access to healthy and nutritious food for the entire community. Share the Warmth recognizes that food is essential to life and necessary for maintaining both physical and mental well-being. Together with our members, we embrace every opportunity to learn, grow, cook, and share meals.

FACING UNCERTAINTY: A TRIPLE CHALLENGE

The food bank offers free support to community residents. It welcomes 3,000 people each month, 30% of whom are under 18. It operates on a choice-based model, empowering members to select food suited to their needs and cultural preferences.

With a 30% rise in food insecurity over the past year, we are launching the “Hope Takes Action” campaign to transform our food bank. Goals: double our capacity, triple storage space, reduce wait times, and make the building fully accessible with an elevator and ramp.
